Acceptance of “Day of Trial”/Late Entries

We will now accept entries after the “pre-entry” closing date.

Up to 350 runs per day.

You may also email or mail the entry after the pre-entry closing date if you don’t want to get to the trial so early. But I must receive it by 11:00 PM on the Thursday preceding the trial and, should you choose not to attend, you are still responsible for the entry fee.

Implementation of “Day of Trial” Change Fee

Preliminary and final confirmation letters are sent to all exhibitors who pre-enter. Exhibitors should check their entry information and notify the trial secretary of any changes that need to be made. Changes requested at the trial will be assessed a

\$15 secretarial processing fee per dog – regardless of who made the error.

PLEASE check your confirmations.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Late Entries

We will accept entries after the pre-entry closing date, up to published limits.

Day of trial entries will be accepted until 9:00 AM on both days.

Refunds

Full refunds will be granted prior to the pre-entry closing date. After that time, refunds will have a \$20 administration fee, will be granted to injured dogs or bitches in season, if the request is presented to the trial secretary no later than noon on Saturday. No refunds will be issued for amounts under \$10.

Eligibility

ASCA agility trials are open to ALL breeds, including mixes. Your dog does NOT have to be registered with ASCA to enter ASCA agility trials. However, to earn titles, you must have a QTracking number or an ASCA Australian Shepherd registration. A QTracking number application is included in this premium.

Championship Program (Division & Levels)

The Championship Program is the original ASCA Agility program.

The Junior Handler Division is open to any dog handled by an exhibitor who is 17 years of age or younger. Dogs entered in the Junior Handlers Division classes MAY jump 4" lower than their regular jump height.

The Veterans Dog Division will be as described in the ASCA Agility rulebook. Dogs entered in the Veterans Dog Division classes MUST jump 4" lower than their regular jump height.

Exhibitors may, at their discretion, enter at a level higher than they have titled.

If they are registered to receive titles, higher level scores will be applied to unearned lower level titles. Note: Once dogs Qualify at the higher level, they cannot return to compete at the lower level.

ACE Program (Divisions & Levels)

The Standard Division is open to any dog 18 months or older. They can jump one height lower than their Championship Standard Division height. Course times for dogs in the ACE program will be 10% greater than the Standard Division dogs in the Championship program.

The Senior Dog Division is open to any dog age seven (7) or older. Dogs entered in the Senior Dog Division will jump 4" lower than their standard jump height the ACE program. Course times for dogs entered in the Senior Dog Division of the Regular Agility and Jumpers classes shall be 10% greater than the SCT for the Standard Division in the ACE program.

FEO

We will accept "For Exhibition Only" (FEO) entries. The minimum age for dogs entered "For Exhibition Only" is 15 months of age. Any dog younger than 18 months of age must jump at a lower height than their regular jump height. Dogs older than 18 months may enter FEO at any jump height and level. Please note that FEO scores will not apply to any ASCA agility titles.

Move-Ups

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted. Pre-trial move-ups must be received by 6:00 pm on the Monday preceding the trial.

Miscellaneous

Titles can be earned under one judge. Twenty points are required for jumpers & gamblers; thirty points for regular. Leashes may be kept with the handler either in their pocket or wearing it as long as the dog does not interact with it.

Height Cards and Measurements

Dogs entering the jump height classes 20" or less (with height less than or equal to 20"), that do not have a permanent ASCA, AKC or NADAC height card must be measured. Dogs entering 20+" or 24" jump heights are exempt.

Equipment

Aframe – 9' sides, rubber granules, slats
 Dog Walk – 12' planks, rubber granules, slats
 Teeter – 12' plank, rubber granules, slatless
 Weave poles – 24" poles - center to center
 Open Tunnels
 Jumps: winged & non winged, double and tire

The A-frame shall be set 5'3".

Electronic timing will be used, including start notice and gamble horns.

Prizes & Awards

Qualifying and 1st through 4th place ribbons will be awarded in each class. A rosette will be awarded to dogs finishing their ATCH. Please note on your entry form if you are close to finishing an ATCH. A title rosette for finishing of each reg level will be given

- This trial will be held according to ASCA Agility regulations. Exhibitors, through submission of their entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. The ASCA Agility Rulebook is available at: www.asca.org
- ASCA, ARF ASCA, and Agility and Rally for Fun will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor.
- All dogs must be on a leash when not competing in the ring or at the practice jump.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create a disturbance may be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refunds will be made.
- Entries from individuals who are not in good standing with ASCA will not be accepted.
- Indoor crating space will be available. You are required to place a tarp, plastic or mat underneath your crates or X-pens. Please consolidate crating as much as possible. A committee member will have the right to consolidate crating as needed.
- Dogs are not allowed to relieve themselves on the building or shrubbery around the building.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement (including hotel site). Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- Do not let your dogs on the grass in front of the building next door. Potty areas are located directly in front of ARF, on the side of the building and across the street.

IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—Please read the following carefully as it, among other things, may prevent you from suing ASCA® and persons/entities affiliated with it. This agreement could even require you to defend them from demands and suits by third parties that include an assertion of wrongdoing by you. (1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as "Applicant"). (2) "Releases" here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its affiliate clubs; and the officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents of ASCA® and of those clubs. (3) This Agreement voluntarily is entered into by Applicant in exchange for the acceptance of the associated entry form and permission to participate in related activities. (4) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations applicable to this event. (5) Applicant certifies that the entered dog will not pose a hazard to people, property, stock animals, or other dogs, and further that the dog is current with rabies shots along with any other vaccinations required by its state of residence. (6) Applicant acknowledges and assumes the risks to Applicant and Applicant's dog associated with participation in the event, among which could be ones associated with poor condition of the facilities and surrounding areas; security measures or lack of them; electrical appliances; fittings; show rings; the presence of unfamiliar persons; and the presence/involvement of other animals—whether stock, dogs, or otherwise. (7) Applicant further agrees to comply with all recommended and required health and safety precautions, among which may be those related to social distancing; quarantining; wearing of face coverings; and non-participation of persons exhibiting symptoms or for whom there otherwise has been a likelihood of recent exposure to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. (8) Applicant additionally acknowledges and agrees to assume the risks associated with taking part in the event though others might neglect compliance with health and safety precautions/requirements or pose an undue risk of spreading disease. For example, as is true as to any public event, there is some risk that Applicant and/or those affiliated with Applicant may catch COVID-19 or another contagious disease at the event. (9) To the maximum extent permitted, this release is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice of law rules. (10) To the extent that Applicant—or another party suing on behalf of Applicant, or suing to recover based on injuries/death/damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property—sues ASCA® (or a board member or staff member or agent of ASCA®) as a defendant, the sole appropriate forum (to the maximum extent permitted by law) for the suit shall be the state or federal courts serving Brazos County, Texas (where ASCA® has its headquarters). (11) Applicant hereby releases and waives any claims Applicant otherwise might assert against the Releaseses as to any injury or damage claim connected in any way to any alleged act or omission arising out of, or occurring concurrent with, the event and related activities, interactions, communications, and even adjacent premises. (12) This release is made not only as to Applicant but also for anyone who might assert a claim on behalf of Applicant or based on purported injury or damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property, as well as any heir, beneficiary, assignee, executor, trustee, agent, or survivor of Applicant. (13) Applicant further agrees to assume sole responsibility for and indemnify and hold Releaseses harmless from related claims, demands, judgments, and settlement payments. (14) These waiver, release, and indemnification provisions extend even to claims or demands asserting that the acts or omissions resulted in bodily injury or death or from intentional wrongdoing, as well as to attorney fees and other costs of defense. (15) The duties of indemnification further extend to any claims or demands asserted against Releaseses that are alleged to have arisen out of the acts or omissions of Applicant, Applicant's dog, or others affiliated with Applicant. Among other things, this means that Applicant would pay the legal defense of Releaseses if someone sued them based on a claim Applicant carelessly exposed the claimant to COVID-19. (16) Applicant's promises in this agreement apply without regard to the type of claim or cause of action asserted against Releaseses. (17) To the extent any provision of this agreement is unenforceable, the remainder of it nonetheless is to be enforced. (18) This agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releaseses with the maximum permissible legal protection from—among other things—claims and suits pursued by Applicant (and/or those acting on behalf of Applicant or over injury/damage to Applicant), as well as from ones based on the purported wrongful acts or omissions of Applicant. (19) Nothing in this Agreement requires you to indemnify Releaseses from claims by third parties that involve no allegations of improper acts or omissions by you, those affiliated with you, nor your dog(s). (20) Applicant acknowledges having read, understood, and had the opportunity for independent legal review of this document prior to signing it.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the total cost for a QT number?

The cost for membership (required) is \$20 per owner if not already a current member.

- The dog owner's membership expires in one year and only needs to be renewed if applying for another dog after it has expired.
- Owners will need to renew their membership each year to keep track of their dog's scores/titles in the online member portal. To sign up for an online account, please visit www.asca.org and click "Register" under Member Login (must have member ID#).

Membership fee is in addition to the QT number fee of **\$20** per dog.

The QT number for the dog will not expire. If the owner is not a current service member, the total cost for one dog plus one owner's membership is **\$40**. QT Numbers for two dogs with one owner's membership would be a total of **\$60**. A QT Number for one dog plus two owners' memberships would be a total of **\$60**. (This is assuming no owners are current members or under 18).

Do I have to have a QT number to compete?

- You do not need a QT number to compete in ASCA Agility, Stockdog or Dock Jumping events, unless you want to earn ASCA title certificates.
- You must have a QT number to compete in ASCA Obedience, Rally and Tracking Tests.

Why would I need or want a QT number for my dog?

To have ASCA keep track of your scores and receive title certificates for your accomplishments.
